

Fee waiver is a concession on the tuition fee, awarded in the ranges of 100%, 50% & 25%.

TYPE OF TUITION FEE WAIVER	WAIVED FEE	FEE TO BE PAID	OTHER EXPENSES
G1	100%	0%	To be paid by student
G2	50%	50%	To be paid by student
G3	25%	75%	To be paid by student
G4	0%	100%	To be paid by student

Fee Waivers only cover tuition fees. Students to pay all other expenses such as:

- 1. Accommodation
- 2. Canteen
- 3. Other miscellaneous costs

FAQs

- Q1. Are the Programmes offered by Indian institutions recognized internationally?
- A. All Indian universities/institutions offering degrees in professional and technical courses are globally recognized with the quality assurance given by national-level statutory bodies viz. NIRF and NAAC.
- Q2. Where can International students gain more information about the courses offered and the institutes under the Study In India programme?
- A. Students can visit the 'Courses' section on www.studyinindia.gov.in to know which institute and course fits their interest.
- Q3. Do International students need to give GRE, GMAT, TOEFL, IELTS or any other test to study in India?
- A. While Indian universities do not insist on such requirements, proficiency in English is a must since the academic programmes are taught in English.
- Q4. What are Tuition Fee Waivers?
- A. Tuition fee waivers are concessions given by institutes on the tuition fees in the ranges of 100%, 50% & 25%. The rest of the charges have to be paid by the student.
